Change Notice

Dear Licensed User,

In accordance with the EFETnet Accession Agreement/Licensed User Agreement (Clause 7.3), we therewith notify you of changes of the EFETnet General Terms and Conditions (GTC) as published on www.efetnet.org.

1. Yearly inflation adjustment to fees

The EFETnet GTC includes an allowance for a yearly inflation adjustment to the fees. Clause 3.9. states as follows:

3.9 All fees will be automatically adjusted by the percentage of the increase/decrease of the official consumer price index (Verbraucherpreisindex) as published by the German Federal Office of Statistics (Statistisches Bundesamt) applicable for the year before such adjustment takes place. (*Example: The indexed price increase in Germany for the year 2007 is 2 percentage points. The fees from 1 January 2009 onwards are increased by 2%.*)

As stated in the Destatis press release 017 from January 15, 2009 (http://www.destatis.de/jetspeed/portal/cms/Sites/destatis/Internet/DE/Presse/pm/2009/01/PD09_017_611.templateId=renderPrint.psm): the averaged rate for 2008 was 2.6%.

In accordance with this average rate the Schedule 1 EFETnet Fee Schedule(s) (http://www.efetnet.org/efetnet/content/e10/e350/index_en.html) for 2010 has been adjusted upwards by 2.6%.

The relevant adjustment will take effect for all payments due from January 2010 onwards.

2. Introduction of fee for 'single internet address' communication service

The EFETnet community has shown excellent growth and now stands at approximately 55 Licensed Users. This success has led to significant efficiency savings for business users. However as the business community has grown the technical overhead associated with maintaining communication links with multiple other participants has also increased creating additional maintenance and configuration costs for Licensed Users. To address this issue EFETnet is introducing a 'single internet address' communication service for all Licensed Users for the purpose of streamlining EFETnet communications. This service will enable Licensed Users to reduce the number of internet addresses that must be configured and maintained from over 55 (as is the current case) down to just one single address for all EFETnet participants.

Benefits of the new service to Licensed User include cost savings derived from:

1. reduced technical overheads associated with management of corporate 'firewalls';
2. simplified configuration of the EFETnet Software;
3. speedier 'take-on' of new counterparties due to reduced complexity in establishing connectivity between EFET Boxes; and
4. mitigation of the impact of conflicting corporate security policies, such as the use of extended IP address ranges by some organisations.

This new service is designed to benefit all Licensed Users equally and to more than offset its cost by the savings it provides, as such it will be applied to the monthly fee for all Licensed Users.

Accordingly an additional charge of:

- EUR 75 (seventy-five) per month (EUR 900 per annum) for all flat monthly rates;
- EUR 25 (twenty-five) per month (EUR300 per annum) for 'SE' users

will take effect as of January 2010 when the service will become available. The additional fee revenue will be used to cover the third party outsourcing costs incurred by EFETnet for provision of a robust and reliable service to the whole community.

3. Action Required by Licensed User

Please review these changes carefully and let us know by 15th January 2010 whether you have any concerns about the changes made. This letter constitutes the Change Notice according to Clause 7.3 of the Accession Agreement.


