## Change Notice 7: Inclusion of the Central Matching Service Addendum

Dear Licensed User,

In accordance with the EFETnet Accession Agreement (Clause 7.3), we herewith notify you of changes to the EFETnet General Terms and Conditions (GTC) as published on [www.efetnet.org](http://www.efetnet.org).

### **Inclusion of EFETnet Central Matching Service Addendum to EFETnet Accession Agreement**

This is a follow-up to the acceptance and approval of the Change Letter 6 procedure incorporating a Central Matching Schedule and Appendix 1 Central Matching Service – Electronic Confirmation Matching Service into the GTC. The Central Matching Schedule is now published on [www.efetnet.org](http://www.efetnet.org)

The attached CENTRAL MATCHING SERVICE ADDENDUM (hereafter referred to as the “Addendum”) further provides the contractual base for the subscribers of the Central Matching Schedule.

### **Action Required by Licensed User**

Please review these changes carefully. This Addendum provides for acceptance of various central matching services (each service referred to as a “Central Matching Service Module”) as an additional service for signatories to the EFETnet Accession Agreement (each signatory being a “Licensed User”). Each Central Matching Service Module must be opted for by Licensed User as set out in enclosed Addendum.



The Central Matching Service Module(s) collectively opted for under this Addendum are referred to as the “Central Matching Service”. The description of the Central Matching Service and other provisions governing the Central Matching Service are set out in the (“Central Matching Service Schedule”) to the General Terms and Conditions both of which are available at [www.efetnet.org](http://www.efetnet.org).

Save for the proposed changes set out in this Change Notice, the EFETnet GTCs shall continue in full force and effect. The provisions of Clause 12.7 of the GTCs shall apply to any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of this Change Notice.

In the event of receipt of Change Notices, such as this one, we invite you also to refer to the site as a central reference for our standard terms of business as they change over time.
